GTA Racing's bringing the Crowd to Winton

Hugh Harrison, driver GTA Racing's 147 GTA Alfa Romeo, is looking forward to another great show of support from the Alpha Romeo community at round 4 of the GT Performance series next weekend at the Winton Motor Raceway.

"Winton is a race close to home and not that far for spectators to travel from Melbourne" said Harrison "Given the great turnout we has at Sandown a few weeks ago and all the support the community has been providing to us, we are expecting to see quite a few people flying the Alpha flag on the weekend."

Interest in GTA Racing has been growing amongst the Alfa Romeo enthusiast community almost daily as the word spreads about their achievements in and plans for their 147 GTA.

"Since we first hit the track in Adelaide, our results have been moving ahead in leaps and bounds. We are continuously improving the car and our track times as we get a better understanding of how the car performs."

"We are in the process of installing a LSD, which should be completed by Winton. This will give us improved corner exit speed and a reduction in wheel spin" continued Harrison. "The team has forecast that we will see substantial improvements in track time with the LSD."

With data collected from the onboard computer, Harrison and his team have already made adjustments to suspension and braking which has seen continual improvements to the cars performance. Given that the LSD is the first major upgrade to the car, some great results are certainly expected.

"The team has worked hard all through the season to improve their understanding of the car so we make the most cost effective improvements to its performance. This has been particularly challenging as there isn't readily available information on how to improve the 147 GTA's performance. Everything we do, we do from scratch" concluded Harrison.

Round 4 of the GT Performance series gets underway on 20 June at Winton Motor Raceway in Victoria.
